


# How do I change my current password on Pterodactyl?

## Step 1

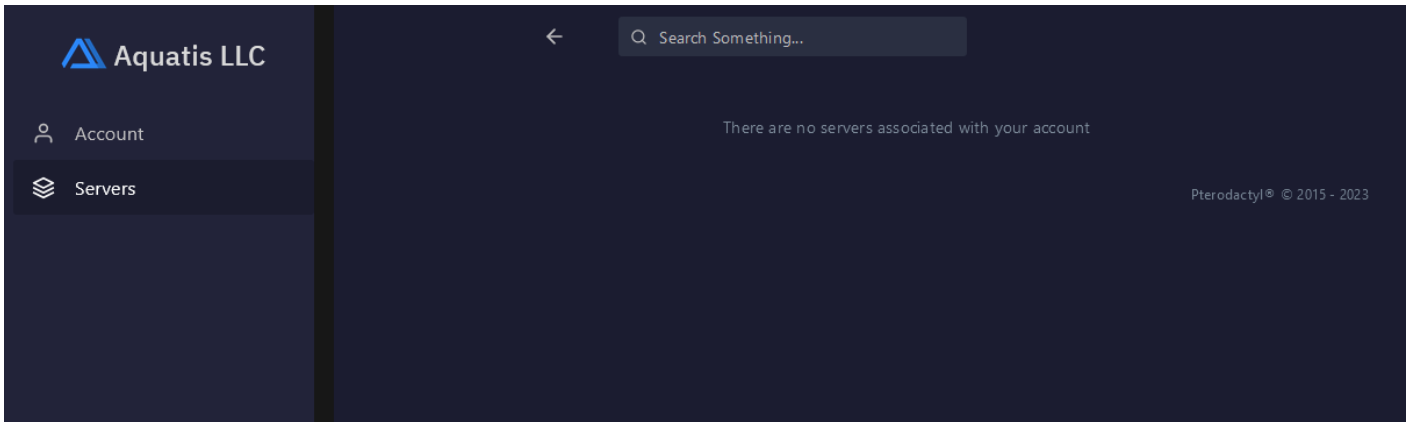
Navigate to [Pterodactyl](#) panel's login screen and **Login**.
