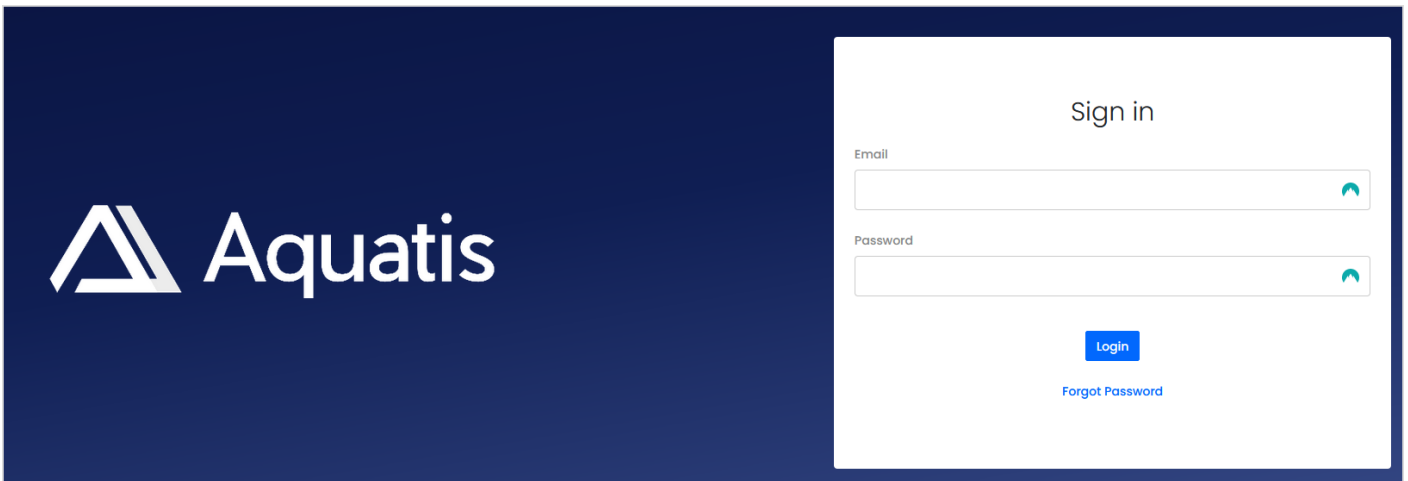


How do I change the password of my VPS?

Step 1

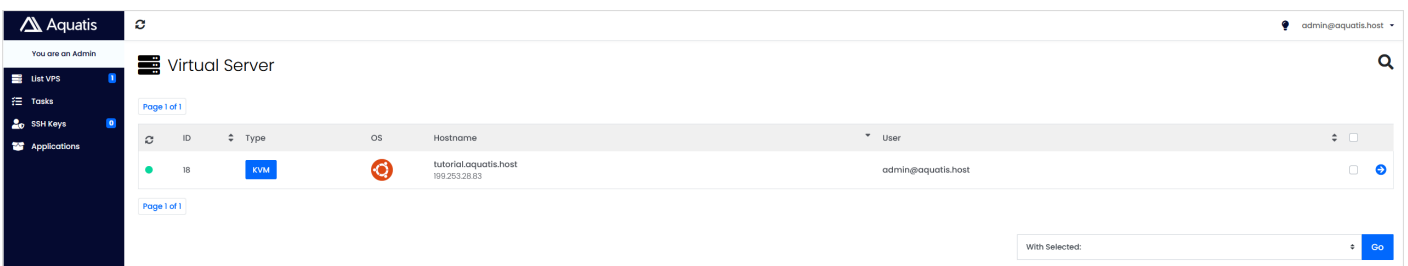
Sign in to the VPS panel.
